Introducing the MA7000 Integrated Amplifier



The new MA7000 Integrated Amplifier is the largest and, at 250 Watts per channel, the most powerful integrated amplifier McIntosh has ever offered. The MA7000 leads an already impressive array of McIntosh integrated amplifiers delivering uncompromised performance in a convenient, single-box solution. An ultralow distortion preamplifier section supports two balanced and four single-ended line-level inputs plus an ultralow-noise, high-gain phono stage that provides enough gain to accommodate medium to high-output MC cartridges in addition to MM cartridges. Two sets of switchable, balanced preamplifier outputs are provided for easy system expansion. A McIntosh designed 5-band equalizer guarantees the range of adjustment necessary to extract the maximum sound quality from a wide variety of audio sources and software.

The amplifier is comprised of a highly linear, two-stage input circuit feeding a high-current-capable, complementary output stage which is terminated in the exclusive McIntosh Output Autoformer. The amplifier delivers its full-rated 250 Watt/channel output into 8, 4, and 2 ohms; adequate to drive a wide variety of loudspeakers to sound their very best.

Superior, fuse-less short circuit protection is provided by the McIntosh Sentry Monitor circuit. Power Guard, a lightening-fast input/output comparator eliminates amplifier clipping without impacting sound quality. McIntosh signature "Blue Eyes" Wattmeters provide visual recognition of amplifier status for an additional measure of protection.



The MSRP of the new McIntosh MA7000 is \$7,000 (U.S. & Canada). Initial shipments are scheduled to begin in December and orders are being accepted now.
